Prior to her current role, Trombley led Iron Mountain's Consulting group responsible for business development, managing a team of subject matter experts, and running large engagements.



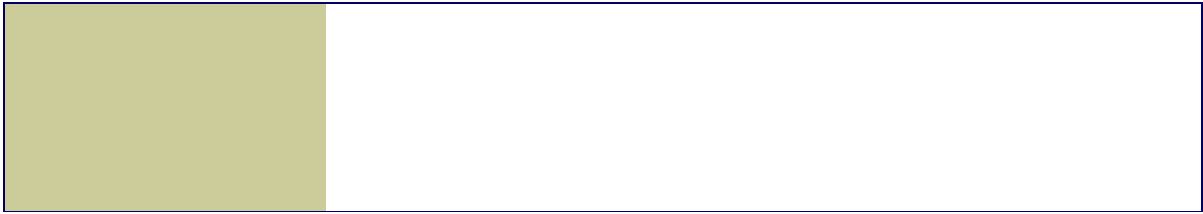
